Conditions of Entries

- Age is as on the 1st November 2014.
- The age groups will be for both female and male - 10 years & under, 11 & 12 Years, 13 & 14 Years, and 15 years & Over.
- There are no qualifying times but club coaches are asked to use some discretion.
- Please note this year we have added in non-competitive events in the following - 50 Free/Back/Breast/Fly and the 100 IM. This is for non-competitive swimmers only.
- **The Roaring Meg Classic** will be swum in the four age group categories of the Meet. The teams will comprise of the first 6 place getters in the 50m **competitive** freestyle events in each of these age groups.

Lane 1	1 st boy	6 th girl
Lane 2	2 nd boy	5 th girl
Lane 3	3 rd boy	4 th girl
Lane 4	4 th boy	3 rd girl
Lane 5	5 th boy	2 nd girl
Lane 6	6 th boy	1 st girl

If there are only 5 swimmers in any age group then the slowest swimmer will be left out E.g. 5 girls/6 boys in an age group then the slowest boy will not swim.

Meet Rules

- All events will be swum as timed finals.

- Events will be single gender and all age groups will be seeded together but scored as separate events.
- Events will be swum under the rules of Swimming New Zealand.
- **Relays** will be Mixed age groups - 10 & under, 11&12 years, 13 & 14, & over. Mixed being 2 Boys & 2 girls, 1 girl 3 boys, or 1 boy 3 girls.
- Relay names to be in to Recorders by the start of each session
- Over the top starts will be used except in all backstroke events.
- In backstroke, entry to the water will be by feet first – no diving
- **Warm ups** will be divided into two half hour sessions; Clubs will be notified of their allotted time.

AWARDS

- Ribbons will be awarded to the first 3 place getters in each event.
- The Cromwell Swim Centre 10th Anniversary Trophy – Male will be awarded to the highest points-scoring male swimmer to hold for 12 months (**not** restricted to Otago swimmers)
- The Cromwell Swim Centre 10th Anniversary Trophy – Female will be awarded to the highest points-scoring female swimmer to hold for 12 months (**not** restricted to Otago swimmers)
- Prize money will accompany trophies to Top Female and Male individuals.
- Prize money will be awarded to the overall highest scoring female and male swimmers in the four **competitive** age groups.
- Prize money to any Otago swimmer who breaks an Otago Short Course record.
- Prize Money to the 1st place getters in each of the four age group categories in the Roaring Meg Classic.
- Points will be awarded as 10, 7, 5, 3, 2, 1 for the first 6 places.

- Entry fee for each individual event is \$7.00
- Relays \$10 per event.
